

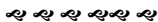

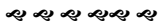

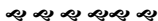
Year 6 Swimming Trials

Option 1: students dropped-off directly at Challenge Stadium by 8.45am.

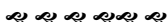
Option 2: drop-off at Chidley by 8.25am. Students will be taken by bus.

Please collect Years 5 and 6 school books from the Claremont Showgrounds (not from the School) from Monday 1 January to Monday 1 February 2010.



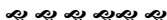
End of Year Music Lunch

Years 1-6 Community Service Day

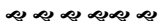
This will be held on **Thursday 26 November** from 12.00-1.30pm at Bay View Campus. Other details as follows:

Years 5 Drama Group Performance

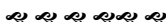
The Year 5 after school drama students will be performing for their parents in the Chidley Campus Music Room on Thursday 26 November from 3.45-4.30pm.



Walk to School and Healthy Snack Day

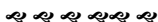

- **No school bags**, bring morning tea and light lunch, in a disposable container



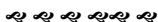
Special Thank You

Students have one week left to borrow books from the Library. Library books must be returned by Friday 27 November.

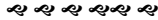


Christmas Holiday Program

The *Cool Christmas* holiday program will run for boys and girls 3 – 9 years. Dates and times as follows:

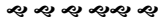

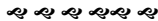
Anglicare Christmas Appeal
