

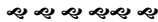

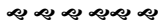
### **End-of-Term Half-Days Extend-ED Available**

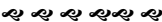
### **Mezze Availability**

Please note the **Mezze will be closed** on Thursday 26 November, Thursday 3 and Friday 4 November.



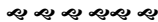
### **Library Books**

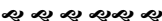


### **Christmas Holiday Program**

The *Cool Christmas* holiday program will run for boys and girls 3 – 9 years. Dates and times as follows:

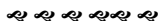

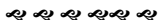
### **Anglicare Christmas Appeal**

## Pilgrimage of Hope

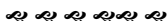

Due to swimming classes during the next two weeks, the children will be telling their news orally and therefore the news basket will not be required. Thank you for supporting the children with this program.



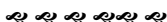
## Pre-Primary News:

## Hand, Foot and Mouth Disease

We have had a case of this disease in Pre-Primary. This is a common, acute, viral infection. Symptoms include fever, blisters in the mouth and on hands and feet. This infection is not related to the Foot and Mouth Disease found in animals. The infection is passed on by direct contact and is not airborne. Parents please wash your child's hands thoroughly with antiseptic. Blisters can be treated with antiseptic for hands and feet and Bonjela for the mouth. Please exclude children from school until blisters have formed crusts.
