Selection Criteria and Procedures

The purpose of the Everist Scholarship in Outdoor Education is to financially support a student so that she may participate in an Outdoor Education program.

Who is eligible?

Students must be in Years 8 to 11 and cannot already be a School scholarship recipient. Students will nominate their first and second choice of Outdoor Education program or trip that they wish to participate in for the current year.

When are applications due?

Applications can be submitted throughout the year.

Selection criteria

The Scholarship is awarded by the selection committee, in consultation with the Principal to the student/s who:

- Demonstrate an interest in or commitment to outdoor pursuits
- Would most benefit from participating in a particular Outdoor Education program
- Requires financial assistance
- Contributes to life at St Hilda's
- Has a referral from teaching staff

The selection committee may choose to interview short-listed candidates.

Duration of the Scholarship

The Scholarship is tenable for one year only, in the year of application. If no suitable candidate is found in a given year, the Scholarship will not be awarded in that year.






