



UNIFORM POLICY – JUNIOR SCHOOL

1. RATIONALE

St Hilda's uniform is attractive and distinctive. Staff, parents and students are reminded and supported to maintain high dress standards for all aspects of school life.

2. SCOPE

The guidelines within this policy relate to all enrolled students at the Junior School, Chidley Campus.

It is important that our dress standards are maintained.

7. GUIDELINES/PROCEDURES

7.1 Uniform Regulations

- Students should wear correct uniform at all times. The uniform can be purchased from the School Clothing Shop. Every item is a regulation item - a specified brand and colour including items such as socks and hair ribbons.
- Students (Years 1-6) wear boaters to and from school in Terms 1 and 4.
- Students (Years 1-6) wear blazers to and from school in Terms 2 and 3.
- Students (Years 1-6) wear blazers to Chapel and assemblies and other formal functions in Terms 2 and 3. No cardigans or jumpers are worn on these occasions.
- In Terms 1 and 4, consistency of uniform for a class is essential. Summer formal functions' attire will be determined according to weather conditions.
- On excursions, at formal functions and when the students are in public, full uniform must be worn, including boater, blazer (Terms 2 and 3) and badges.
- Students (Years 1-6) are required to wear their House badges throughout the year.
- Hair must not be dyed beyond natural colourings. It should be neat and tied back once it reaches the collar. Hair ribbons, headbands and cloth scrunchies must be regulation blue. Hair ties, Alice bands or clips should be brown.
- Make-up and nail polish should not be worn.
- Braids (from overseas holidays) or body markings such as henna tattoos are not permitted.
- One pair of small gold or silver studs, no larger than 4mm in diameter, with one worn in each lower ear lobe, is permitted. These studs are available through the Uniform Shop.

- Only plain watches/ Fitbits/Apple watches* with plain bands are allowed i.e. brown, black, pale blue, white, gold or silver. *Apple watches are discouraged due to their internet connection capability.
- Please ensure that each article of clothing is clearly marked with the current owner's name.

7.2 Junior Kindergarten, Kindergarten and Pre Primary

7.2.1 Girls

- Pale blue short-sleeved shirt
- Pale blue cardigan with crest
- Blue denim pinafore with crest
- Pale blue short socks - not to be worn with sandals
- Navy blue tights for winter
- Hair ribbons, head bands or cloth scrunchies must be regulation blue. Only brown hair ties, Alice bands or clips are to be worn.

7.2.2 Boys

- Pale blue short-sleeved shirt - with Crest
- Pale blue cardigan with crest – with Crest
- Navy blue trousers (winter)
- Navy blue shorts
- Pale blue socks - not to be worn with sandals

7.2.3 Sports Uniform

Sports uniform is worn on Physical Education days only. Please label all items with current owner's name.

- Pale blue fleecy tracksuit pants and top with zip
- Short and long-sleeved pale blue polo shirt with crest
- Navy blue shorts with yellow and pale blue stripe (girls)
- Navy shorts
- Pale blue socks
- Pale blue hat
- Bathers and rash vest for Kindergarten and Pre Primary students only. Junior Kindergarten do not take swimming lessons

7.2.4 General Items

General items all available from the St Hilda's Shop include: library bag, raincoat, backpack.

7.2.5 Footwear: Available from *Athletes Foot*

- Summer Open toe navy sandal
- Winter **Girls:** brown lace up
Velcro fastening shoe
Boys: elastic-sided brown boot size: 10-6 or other plain brown boots or shoes
- Sports shoes Velcro fastening preferred. Please limit shoe selection to subtle colours.

7.3 Years 1- 6

7.3.1 Summer Uniform

- 2 Grey dresses
- 1 Blazer
- 1 Cardigan (optional) not to be worn to and from school unless under the blazer
- 1 Boater
- 4 Pale blue turn down cuff short socks, no cuffless socks
- 1 Pale blue polo shirt
- 1 Navy shorts with yellow and blue stripe
- 1 House polo shirt

7.3.2 Sports uniform

Sports Uniform is worn on Physical Education and Dance days only. Please label all items with current owner's name.

- 1 Pale blue fleecy tracksuit (Years 1- 2)
- 1 Pale blue microfibre tracksuit (Years 3-6)
- 1 Hat
- 1 Bather two piece (Years 1-2)
- 1 Bather with rash shirt (Years PP-6)
- 1 House swimming cap (Years PP-6)
- 1 St Hilda's interschool swimming cap (Years P-6)
- 1 Swimming towel (optional)

7.3.3 General items

General items are all available from the St Hilda's shop: pale blue ribbon, scrunchies or head band, 1 library bag (Years 1-2), 1 homework bag (Years 1-4), 1 school backpack, 1 sports bag (Years 1-6), 1 chair bag (Years 1-2).

7.3.4 Years 1- 6 Winter Uniform

- 1 Blazer
- 2 Pale blue long or short sleeved shirts
- 1 Jumper
- 2 Tunics
- 1 Tie
- 4 Grey tights (formal)
- Cuffed short socks (no long socks)
- Optional: Scarf for Years 5 and 6 only to be worn to and from school. No scarf for JK to Year 4.

7.3.5 Footwear: Available from *Athletes Foot*

- Years 1-2 Open toe navy sandal
- Years 1 to 6: Brown lace-ups
- Sports Shoes Please limit shoe selection to subtle colours.

7.4 Physical Education (PE) Uniform

Junior Kindergarten- Year 6, on PE and Dance days, travel to and from school in PE uniform and stay in PE uniform all day. Years 1-6 students can wear PE uniform on timetabled Dance

lessons during the school day if not on a Wednesday when there is Assemblies/Chapel services.

Exceptions:

If students have a cocurricular activity before school that requires PE uniform on a non PE day, they can travel to school but then must change prior to class time.

If students have a cocurricular activity after school that requires PE uniform on a non PE day, they are required to change into their PE after school. Students may travel home in their PE uniform.

8. BREACH

If students breach this policy, they may be subject to disciplinary actions.
