



UNIFORM POLICY – SENIOR SCHOOL

1. RATIONALE

St Hilda's uniform is attractive and distinctive. Staff, parents and students are reminded and supported to maintain high dress standards for all aspects of school life.

2. SCOPE

The guidelines within this policy relate to all enrolled students at the Senior School, Bay View Campus.

It is important that our dress standards are maintained.

The School uniform is inclusive of all apparel.

7. GUIDELINES/PROCEDURES

7.1 Uniform Regulations

- Students should wear correct uniform at all times. The uniform can be purchased from the School Shop. Every item is a regulation item - a specified brand and colour including items such as socks and hair ribbons.
- Students (Years 7-12) wear boaters to and from school in Terms 1 and 4.
- Students (Years 7-12) wear blazers to and from school in Terms 2 and 3.
- Students (Years 7-12) wear blazers to Chapel and assemblies and other formal functions in Terms 2 and 3. No cardigans or jumpers are worn on these occasions.
- In Terms 1 and 4, consistency of uniform for a class is essential. Summer formal functions' attire will be determined according to weather conditions.
- On excursions, at formal functions and when the students are in public, full uniform must be worn, including boater, blazer (Terms 2 and 3) and badges.
- Students (Years 7-12) are required to wear their House badges throughout the year.
- Hair must not be dyed beyond natural colourings. It should be neat and tied back once it reaches the collar of the uniform. Hair ribbons, headbands and cloth scrunchies must be regulation blue. Hair ties, Alice bands or clips should be brown.
- Make-up and nail polish should not be worn.
- Braids or body markings such as henna tattoos are not permitted.
- No facial piercings permitted.
- One pair of small gold or silver studs, no larger than 4mm in diameter, with one worn in each lower ear lobe, is permitted. These studs are available through the School Shop.

- Only plain watches/ Fitbits with plain bands are allowed i.e. brown, black, pale blue, white, gold or silver.
- Please ensure that each article of clothing is clearly marked with the current owner's name.

7.2 Senior School Summer and Winter Uniform

7.2.1 Summer Uniform

- Grey skirt (summer weight) the regulation length is mid-knee
- Blazer
- Pale blue overblouse
- Boater – must be worn with uniform out of School grounds in terms 1 and 4
- Blue ankle socks
- Pale blue hair ribbons, scrunchies, brown or black hair ties and black or brown hair clips are worn
- Cardigan (optional, only worn in School grounds)

7.2.2 Summer Uniform Formal Occasions

- Girls wear regulation uniform as above
- Tie
- Tan stockings

7.2.3 Winter Uniform

- Grey skirt (winter weight) the regulation length is mid-knee
- Blazer
- Pale blue overblouse
- Blazer retained from Summer
- Jumper
- Tie
- Grey tights or blue ankle socks
- Scarf and gloves (optional)

7.2.4 Winter Uniform Formal Occasions

- Girls wear regulation uniform as above

7.2.5 Sports Uniform

- Pale blue micro-fibre tracksuit
- Pale blue polo shirt with crest
- Navy shorts with yellow and blue stripe
- Navy sports cap with crest
- House polo shirt
- Bathers
- Rash shirt (optional)
- House bathing cap
- Towel (optional)
- Sports bag

7.2.6 Sports Uniform for Travelling to other Venues and Interschool Teams

Summer

- Navy shorts, blue polo shirt, blue sports socks and white sandshoes

Tennis

- White tennis polo with St Hilda's crest, navy shirt, blue sports socks and navy sports cap

Winter

- Tracksuits are worn to and from venue
- Long blue socks and boots are worn for Hockey
- Girls who represent the School in sporting teams require two blue shirts
- The physical education staff determine specific clothing for school teams

Shoes

- Day Shoe – Brown lace-up School shoe
- Sport Shoe – please limit shoe selection to subtle colours

7.2.7 General Items

General items all available from the School Shop: school backpack; sports bag; earrings, pale blue ribbon, scrunchies, and other items

7.2.8 Footwear: Available from *Murray's and Athletes Foot*

- Summer Brown lace up
- Winter Brown lace up
- Sports shoes Please limit shoe selection to subtle colours

7.2.9 Jewellery

Regulation 4mm studs are available at the School Shop.

Students who experience allergic reactions to earrings should follow the guidelines below:

- Hypoallergenic studs
- Surgical steel
- Plastic earring posts
- 14-karat gold studs (check there is no nickel component)
- Or, not wear earrings while in uniform
