7. GUIDELINES/PROCEDURES

7.1. Uniform Regulations

- Students must wear correct uniform at all times. The uniform can be purchased from the Uniform Shop. Every item is a regulation item a specified brand and colour including items such as socks and hair ribbons.
- The regulation length for dresses/tunics is mid-knee length
- Students (Years 1-6) wear boaters to and from school in Terms 1 and 4.
- Students (Years 1-6) wear blazers to and from school in Terms 2 and 3.
- Summer formal function attire will be determined according to weather conditions.
- On excursions, at formal functions and when the students are in public, full uniform must be worn, including boater, blazer (Terms 2 and 3) and badges.
- Physical Education (PE) Uniform: Junior Kindergarten Year 6, on PE days, travel to and from school in PE uniform and stay in PE uniform all day.



- Dance Uniform: Pre Primary to Year 6 students will bring their long black leggings and their pale blue polo shirt with crest to school for dance lessons. Students will change into and out of their dance uniform at school.
- Exceptions: If students have a cocurricular activity before school that requires PE
 uniform on a non-PE day, they can travel to school but then must change prior to class
 time. If students have a cocurricular activity after school that requires PE uniform on a
 non-PE day, they are required to change into their PE uniform after school. Students
 may travel home in their PE uniform.
- Students are required to wear their House badge throughout the year.
- Hair must not be dyed beyond natural colourings. It must be neat and tied back once
 it reaches the collar. Hair ribbons must be regulation stripe. Headbands and cloth
 scrunchies must be regulation blue. Hair ties, snap clips and bobby pins must be the
 same colour as the student's hair colour. I.e. black hair requires black hair tie but must
 be worn in conjunction with a regulation stripe blue ribbon. All available at the Uniform
 Shop.
- School sun hats must be worn at all times when outside. Students who do not have an appropriate sun protective hat will be asked to stay in shaded areas only.
- Make-up and nail polish must not be worn.
- Braids (from cultural overseas holidays) or body markings such as henna tattoos are not permitted.
- One pair of small gold or silver studs, no larger than 4mm in diameter, with one worn in the first piercing of each lower ear lobe, is permitted. These studs are available through the Uniform Shop.
- Watches with plain bands are allowed i.e. brown, black, blue, white, gold or silver.
 *Smart watches are discouraged due to their internet connection capability and must be signed in to the Junior School Reception at the beginning of the school day.
- Religious necklaces e.g. crucifix are permitted to be worn under the School uniform.
 They are not to be in sight and are to be removed during any physical activity and/or lessons which could potentially be a health and safety hazard.
- Please ensure that each article of clothing is clearly marked with the current owner's name.

7.2. Junior Kindergarten, Kindergarten and Pre Primary Uniform

Girls' Summer Uniform (Term 1 and Term 4)

- Pale blue short-sleeved shirt
- Blue denim pinafore with crest
- Pale blue ankle socks (not to be worn with sandals)
- School sun hat

Girls' Winter Uniform (Term 2 and Term 3)

- Blue denim pinafore with crest
- Pale blue short-sleeved shirt
- Pale blue cardigan with crest / Pale blue and yellow hoody
- Navy tights or pale blue ankle socks (not to be worn with sandals)
- School sun hat

Boys Summer Uniform

- Navy shorts
- Pale blue short-sleeved shirt with crest
- Pale blue socks (not to be worn with sandals)
- School sun hat

Boys Winter Uniform

- Navy blue trousers
- Pale blue short-sleeved shirt with crest
- Pale blue cardigan with crest / Pale blue and yellow hoody
- Blue ankle socks
- School sun hat

Sports Uniform

Sports uniform is worn on Physical Education and excursion days only.

- Pale blue fleecy tracksuit pants and pale blue and yellow hoody
- Short or long-sleeved pale blue polo shirt with crest
- Navy blue shorts with yellow and pale blue stripe (girls)
- Navy shorts
- Pale blue socks
- School sun hat
- House polo shirt (Pre Primary only for Term 4)

Swimming



• Bathers and rash vest for Kindergarten and Pre Primary students only. Junior Kindergarten do not take swimming lessons.

Dance Uniform (Pre Primary only, during dance lessons only)

- Pale blue polo shirt with crest
- Long black leggings (Pre Primary only)

Footwear

- Summer Open toe navy sandal
- Winter Girls: brown velcro fastening shoe or lace up
- Winter Boys: elastic-sided brown boot or other plain brown boots or shoe
- Sports shoes Velcro fastening preferred. Please limit shoe selection to subtle colours

7.3. Years 1-6 Uniform

Summer Uniform and Summer Formal Occasions

- Grey dress with crest
- Blazer, with House badge
- Boater
- Pale blue ankle socks
- School sun hat

Winter Uniform and Winter Formal Occasions

- Blazer, with House badge
- Pale blue short sleeved shirts
- Jumper
- Tunic
- Tie
- Grey tights (formal) or pale blue ankle socks
- School sun hat
- Scarf and gloves (optional for Year 5 and 6 only).



Sports Uniform (worn on PE Days only)

- Pale blue polo shirt with crest
- House polo shirt
- Navy Shorts with yellow and blue stripe
- Pale blue microfibre track pant (Year 1-2)
- Pale blue microfibre tracksuit (Years 3-6)
- Pale blue and yellow hoody
- School sun hat

Swimming

- Bathers with rash shirt
- House swimming cap
- St Hilda's interschool swimming cap (JIGSSA Only)

Dance Uniform (during dance lessons only)

- Pale blue polo shirt with crest
- Long black leggings

Footwear

- Years 1–2: Open toe navy sandal
- Years 1-6: Brown lace-ups (Available from Athletes Foot Karrinyup or Claremont)
- Sports Shoes: Please limit shoe selection to subtle colours.

7.4. General Items

General items available from the St Hilda's Shop include regulation hair accessories, school sun hat, swimming caps, sports bag, library bag, swimming bag, towel, and small backpack.
