St Hilda's uniform is attractive and distinctive. Staff, parents and students are reminded and supported to maintain high dress standards for all aspects of school life.

7. GUIDELINES/PROCEDURES

7.1. Uniform Regulations

- Students must wear the correct uniform at all times. The uniform can be purchased from the Uniform Shop. Every item is a regulation item - a specified brand and colour including items such as socks and hair ribbons.
- The regulation length for skirts is mid-knee
- Students wear boaters to and from school in Terms 1 and 4.
- Students wear blazers to and from school in Terms 2 and 3.
- Students wear blazers to Chapel, assemblies, and other formal functions in Terms 2 and 3. No jumpers are worn on these occasions as the outer layer.
- Summer formal function attire will be determined according to weather conditions.
- On excursions, at formal functions and when the students are in public, full uniform must be worn, including boater, blazer (Terms 2 and 3) and badges.
- Students are required to wear their House badges throughout the year.

- Hair must not be dyed beyond natural colourings. It must be neat and tied back once it reaches the collar of the uniform. Hair ribbons must be regulation stripe. Headbands and cloth scrunchies must be regulation blue. Hair ties, snap clips and bobby pins must be the same colour as the student's hair colour. I.e. black hair requires black hair tie, but must be worn in conjunction with a regulation blue stripe ribbon.
- Make-up and nail polish must not be worn.
- Braids or body markings such as henna or visible tattoos are not permitted.
- No facial piercings permitted.
- One pair of small gold or silver studs, no larger than 4mm in diameter, with one worn in the first piercing of each lower ear lobe, is permitted. These studs are available through the Uniform Shop.
- Watches / Fitbits with plain bands are allowed i.e. brown, black, blue, white, gold or silver. Smartwatches cannot be worn during any assessments (e.g. tests, exams).
- Religious necklaces, e.g. crucifix, are permitted to be worn under the School uniform. They are not to be in sight and are to be removed during any physical activity and/or lessons, which could potentially be a health/safety hazard.
- Please ensure that each article of clothing is clearly marked with the current owner's name.

7.2. Senior School Summer Uniform

- Grey skirt or full-length tailored grey trousers
- Pale blue overblouse
- Boater
- Blue ankle socks
- Blazer with House badge (optional in cooler weather)
- Jumper (optional in cooler weather)

7.3. Senior School Summer Uniform Formal Occasions

- Girls wear regulation summer uniform as above with a tie

7.4. Senior School Winter Uniform

- Grey skirt or full-length tailored grey trousers
- Blazer with House badge
- Pale blue overblouse
- Tie
- Grey tights or blue ankle socks
- Jumper (optional)
- Scarf and gloves (optional)

7.5. Senior School Winter Uniform Formal Occasions

- Girls wear regulation winter uniform as above

7.6. Senior School Sports Uniform

- Pale blue micro-fibre tracksuit pant
- Pale blue sports jacket
- Pale blue and yellow hoody
- Pale blue polo shirt with crest or bumblebee blue polo shirt
- Navy shorts with yellow and blue stripe
- Navy sports cap with crest
- House polo shirt
- Bathers
- House bathing cap

7.7. Senior School Sports Uniform for travelling to other venues and IGSSA Teams

The physical education staff determine specific clothing for school teams

Summer

- Navy shorts/skort, bumblebee blue polo shirt/singlet, blue sports socks

Tennis

- White tennis polo with St Hilda's crest, navy skort, blue sports socks and navy sports cap

Winter

- Tracksuits are worn to and from the venue
- Long blue socks and boots are worn for Hockey, Soccer and AFL

7.8. General Items

- General items are all available from the Uniform Shop: school backpack, sports bag, earrings, regulation ribbons, scrunchies, towels, etc.
