Is laundry taken care of?	✓		At St Hilda's, our on-site laundry team keeps uniforms tidy and bedding clean. Girls develop independence by taking responsibility for washing their own personal laundry.
Are activities on offer on weekends?	✓		At St Hilda's, we offer a full weekend recreation program, both on and off campus. Boarders have access to on-site facilities including the pool, gym, sports centre, and off campus activities like dances, Bounce, and Adventure World, beach and shopping centre visits. Often recreation activities are in conjunction with other like schools.
Does the Boarding House offer pastoral care on weeknights and weekends?	✓		At St Hilda's, each boarding area has designated 'Housies' for weeknight and weekend support, helping girls build strong relationships and feel cared for.
Do you provide academic support?	✓		At St Hilda's, homework prep is led by past boarding students and Old Scholars, with additional tutoring available from classroom teachers at our Tute Centre.
Is there much available in the surrounding area?	✓		St Hilda's Boarding House is situated in Mosman Park, walking distance to the Swan River and a short distance away from Cottesloe Beach. Girls can walk to the local shops and have access to dedicated boarding bikes to explore the area.
